VERNON COUNTY ORDINANCE # 01-93

VERNON COUNTY HAULING LICENSE RULES

1. License will be issued on or after January 1st and will remain in effect until December 31st of that year.
2. If a licensed hauler acquires an additional truck during the license year, he/she will notify the Vernon County Solid Waste Department to agree on a new truck identification number.
3. All license holders will transport solid waste in an enclosed vehicle or shall transport the rubbish in containers which will prevent littering or spilling while in transit.
4. If a municipal collection site container or dumpster is not serviced weekly and its contents become a health hazard as defined by the Vernon County Health Ordinance #1-86, either at site or at the county facility, service will be increased or some action taken to remedy the situation. Each dumpster or container must be kept in good repair so that no site attendant or person handling a commercial container will be injured. An effort will be made to keep these containers as sanitary as possible to prevent insect breeding, odors and unhealthy conditions from developing. These dumpsters or containers will be replaced by the owner when not in good repair. No hazardous or toxic waste as defined by local, state or federal laws or Vernon County Solid Waste Management Committee regulations will be placed in these dumpsters or containers.
5. Limited time permits for non-licensed haulers will be available for short term disposal projects (demolition, etc.), but not including the hauling of residential solid waste. Vernon County must be notified two weeks prior to demolition of any building so site may be inspected for the presence of hazardous material.
6. All license holders must comply with all federal, state and local regulations, including those related to the collection, transportation and disposal of solid waste.
7. All license holders will supply a certificate of the following types of insurance issued to the licensee by insurers, duly licensed within the State of Wisconsin, general liability including, but not limited to, bodily injury, property damage, motor vehicle, loading and unloading and provide appropriate worker's compensation benefits insurance.
8. Haulers must provide Vernon County with a schedule outlining the days, times and locations of the first pick up points and a description of each route at the time a hauling license is issued.
9. The Vernon County Solid Waste Department has the right to inspect the hauler's trucks and contents whenever the trucks are in Vernon County.
10. The applicant shall be financially and operationally capable, as determined by the Vernon County Solid Waste Management Committee, of properly collecting, transporting and paying for disposal of all solid waste. Payments are due thirty (30) days after postmark date of statement.
11. License holder agrees to deliver all acceptable solid waste, as defined by the Vernon County Solid Waste Management Committee, picked up in Vernon County to the Vernon County Solid Waste Facility; however, no waste from outside the County will be accepted without a prior agreement.
12. Dumping of solid waste at the landfill site is allowed only when an authorized Vernon County employee is available to observe the weighing and unloading of the truck.
13. If any hazardous or unacceptable waste is delivered to the landfill or processing facility, the hauler will be notified for removal and if the hauler does not remove the material in the agreed upon time frame, not to exceed closing of the following work day, Vernon County will dispose of the waste in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations. The hauler will be billed double the county's disposal costs incurred.
14. The license holder agrees that it will at all times during the existence of this license save harmless Vernon County against any and all liability, loss, damage, costs or expenses which license holder may sustain, incur, or cause as a result of an act the hauler either has done or has failed to do.
15. All haulers will use STH 14, CTH Y, and CTH LF to access the facility. Haulers who fail to follow this route may have their license suspended.
16. If any licensed holder does not abide by these guidelines and guidelines in their municipal contracts, they will be cited and assessed a fine or fee as clearly stated in the Vernon County Solid Waste Ordinance. Three or more violations within a twelve-month time period may result in the suspension of the hauling license and the hauler losing his right to haul solid waste in Vernon County.
17. License fees will be credited to the license holder account but must be used during the course of the license year.
