### Before Placing in Your Recycler:

- Rinse plastic, glass, tin, and aluminum containers.
- Remove lids from glass and plastic containers.
- Remove labels from tin cans.
- Place mixed papers and paper board in paper bags or loose into your towns container.  
(Please do not put paper into plastic bags.)

### Other Recyclable Items

#### Bulbs and Ballasts:

CFL and Fluorescents- \$.50 ea.

Other Types- \$2.00-\$5.00 ea.

#### Tires:

Auto or Light Truck- \$2.50 ea.

Large Truck- \$10.00 ea.

Tractor or Large Quantities- \$225.00 per ton

#### E-Waste and Appliances:

Computers, Televisions, Printers, Refrigerators  
Microwaves, etc.- \$15.00 ea.
