

LAW ENFORCEMENT COMMITTEE MEETING
February 13, 2014

Vice Chair Kevin Gobel called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. Committee members present:

Gobel confirmed that the Agenda was properly posted. Cade moved to approve the minutes of the January 9, 2014 meeting. Mitchell seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Coroner Reed presented her invoices in the amount of \$1427.73. Mitchell moved to pay the coroner bills, Cade seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

The Sheriff's invoices were reviewed and explanations provided as requested. Cade moved and Mitchell seconded a motion to pay the invoices in the sum of \$118,517.63, which motion passed unanimously. The bills, higher than normal, included jail doctor bills from Vernon Memorial dating back to October, 2011.

Dr. Menn is retiring from the hospital and has been the jail doctor since the 1980s. The Sheriff is exploring options on inmate medical coverage. The Sheriff is also reviewing protective status for jailers. Cade and Mitchell both urged the Sheriff to move forward on that option. Gobel asked if a fiscal impact statement had been completed.

Mitchell moved to adjourn, Cade seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.
