

LAW ENFORCEMENT COMMITTEE MEETING
November 13, 2014

Chair Frank McCoy called the meeting to order at 8:02 a.m. Committee members present:

Coroner Janet Reed was also present.

McCoy confirmed that the Agenda was properly posted. Mitchell moved to approve the minutes of the October 13, 2014 meeting. Cade seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Coroner Reed presented the Coroner bills in the amount of \$6749.37, which included three autopsy invoices. Cade moved to approve the bills, Mitchell seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously. Coroner's income for the month was \$500.00.

The Sheriff's invoices were reviewed and explanations provided as requested. Cade moved and Easterday seconded a motion to pay the invoices in the sum of \$49,286.48, which motion passed unanimously.

In his report to the Committee, the Sheriff talked about the search for the Mexican tourist. The assistance received by the Vernon County Sheriff's Office from KERT (K9 Emergency Response Teams, Inc) was what ultimately led to the finding of Goudensio Gayton. Easterday asked about a traffic accident with injuries on County Road D, Town of Clinton. The Sheriff commended Highway Commissioner Phil Hewitt on the work he did and the results that are already showing with the gasoline purchases.

Easterday moved to adjourn, Mitchell seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously. The next meeting will be December 11, 2014.
